## 'Set Price To' Discounts

Patheon users can now easily create one discount for all plans with the 'Set Price To' option. This feature enables organizations to reduce the number of discounts they must set up and is unaffected by price changes. 'Set Price To' makes managing discounts faster and more efficient:

- All sites need to configure is the discounted price – the amount due after the discount is applied.
- Automatically factors and calculates different tax rates across multiple sites
- Works with item(s), product type(s) and new plan members
- Works with coupon/promo code discounts and automatic discounts
- Works across multi-site organizations – the discount follows the item's, product type's or plan's configuration.

### Configuring a 'Set Price To' Discount

Use these steps to add and configure a new **Set Price To** discount.

1. Log in to Patheon Portal.
2. Select **Discounts**. The **DISCOUNTS** panel opens.
3. Select **ADD DISCOUNT**. The **ADD DISCOUNTS (1 CONDITIONS)** panel opens.
4. In **Name\***, enter the discount name.
5. In **Type\***, select **Coupon** or **Automatic**. **Note: Set Price To** discounts can be either type.
6. Configure the discount conditions. **Note: Set Price To** discounts can be applied to items, product types or plans.
7. Select **CONTINUE**. The **ADD DISCOUNTS (2 ACTIONS)** panel opens.
8. In **Type of Discount\***, select **Set Price To**.
9. In **Discounted Price\***, enter the price charged after the discount is applied, for example, **10.00**.
10. Select **CONTINUE**. The **ADD DISCOUNTS (3 ACTIVATION)** panel opens.
11. In **Status\***, select **Active**.
12. Select **SAVE**.

## 'Set Price To' Examples

The following are examples of **Set Price To** configuration for items, product types and plans.

### Item(s)

- Plans can now be activated for site groups (or deactivated for a site group), in addition to individual or select individual sites.
- Products can now be activated for site groups (or deactivated for a site group), in addition to individual or select individual sites.



Use these steps to add a new site group in Patheon Portal. Site groups can be selected when configuring where products or plans are active. **Note:** A site can only belong to one site group at a time.

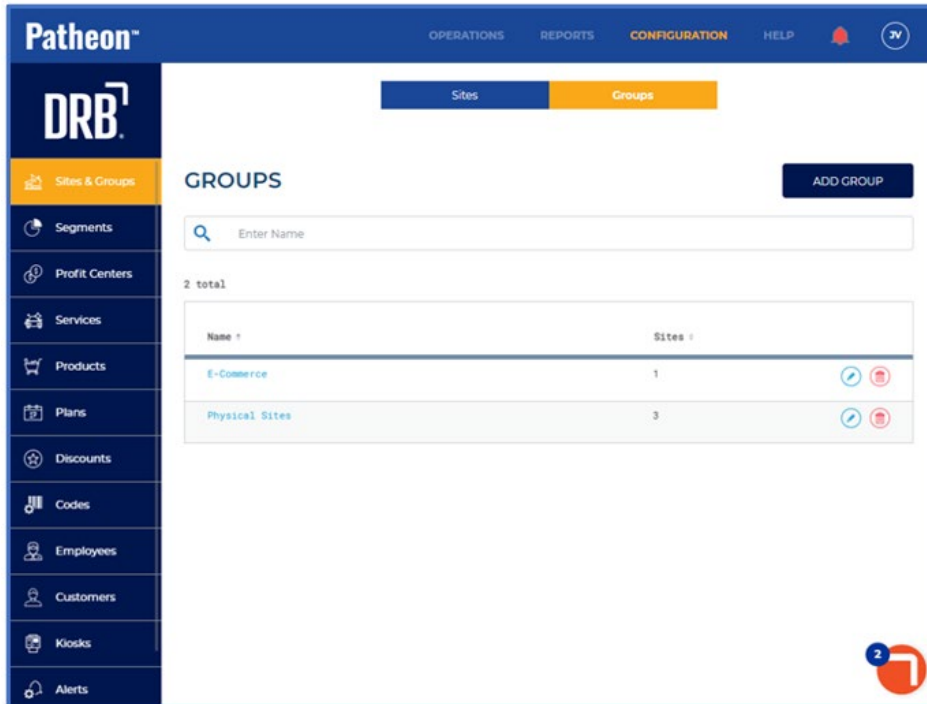
1. Log in to Patheon Portal.
2. Select **Sites & Groups**. The **SITES** panel opens.



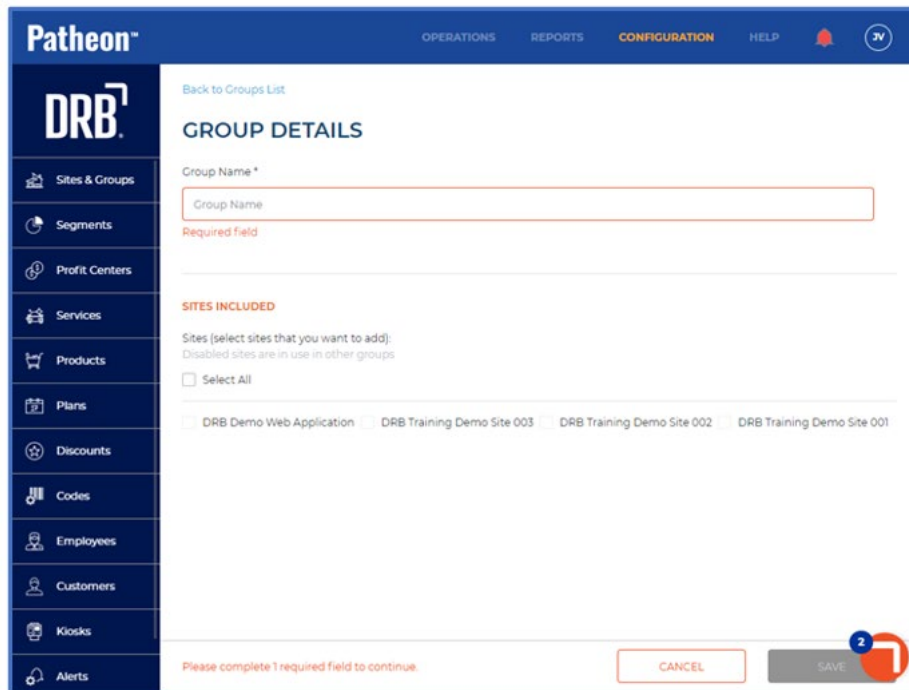

5. In **Group Name\***, enter the name of the new site group.

6. In the **SITES INCLUDED** section, select a site to add it to the new group. A check mark appears next to the site. **Note:** If a site already belongs to another site group, it can't be added to the new site group.
7. Select any additional sites to add to the group.
8. Select **SAVE**. An **Are you sure?** confirmation dialog opens.
9. Select **SAVE**. The dialog closes and the changes are saved.

## Delete a Site Group

Use these steps to delete an existing site group in Patheon Portal. Note: A site group can be deleted even if it has sites assigned to it.

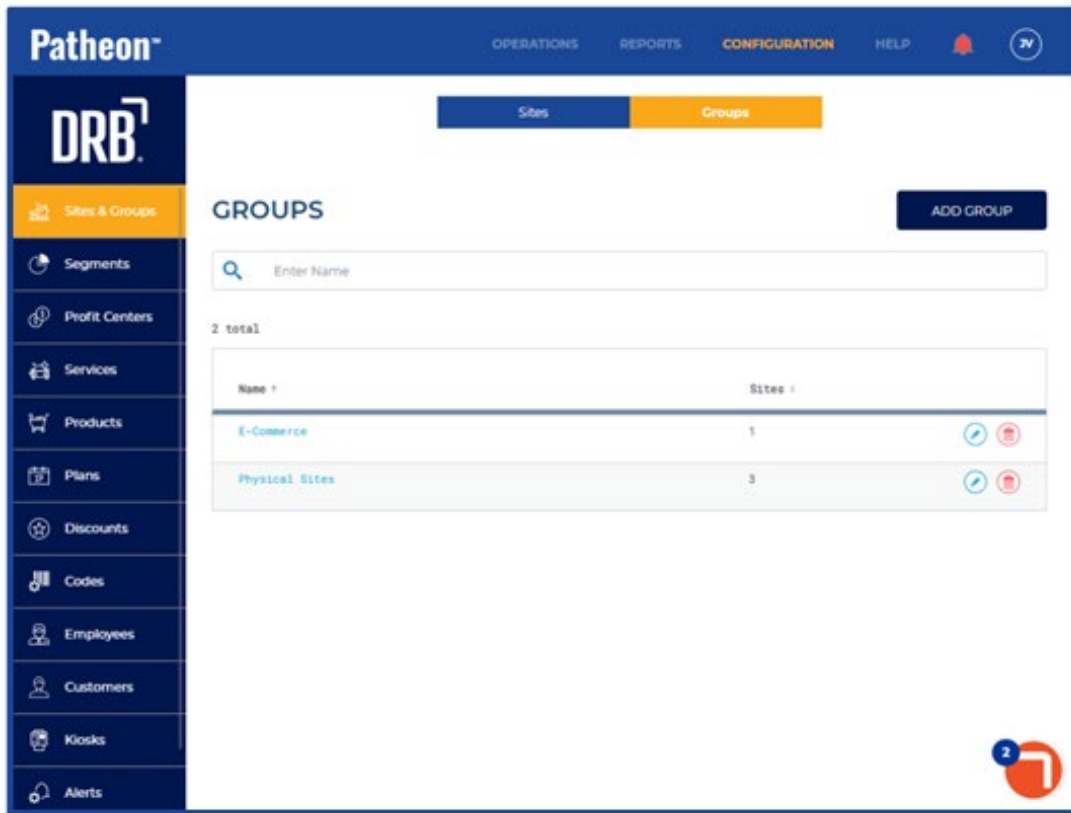
1. Log in to Patheon Portal.
2. Select **Sites & Groups**. The **SITES** panel opens.

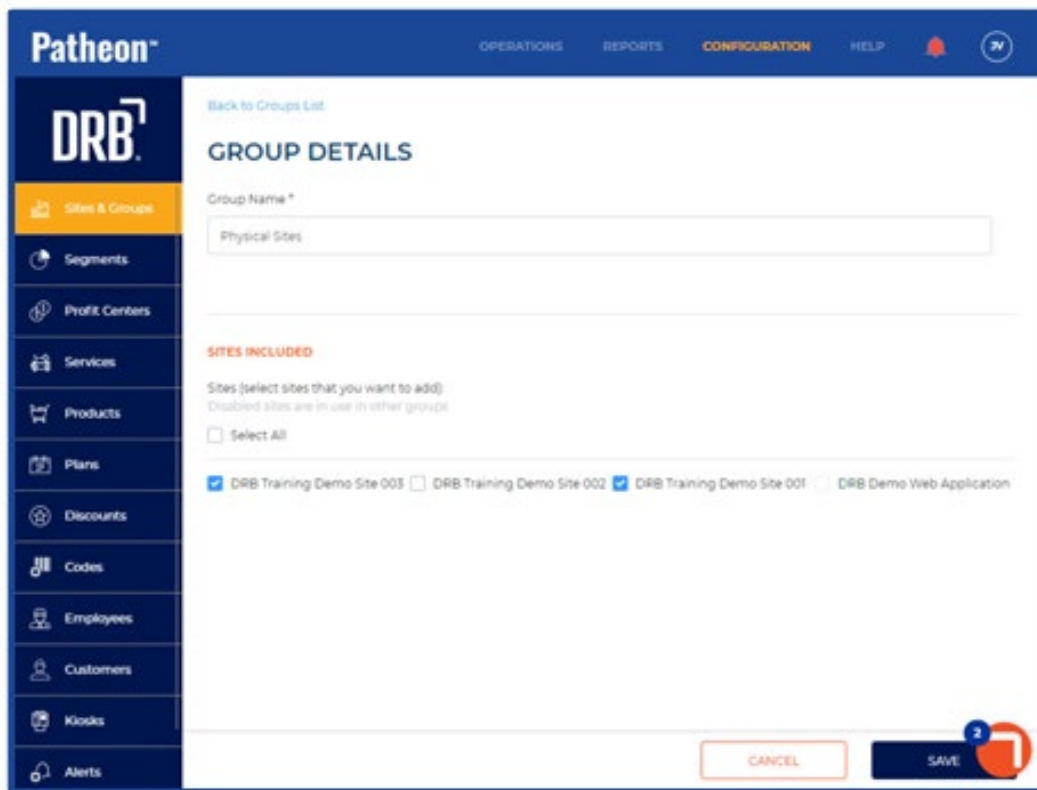

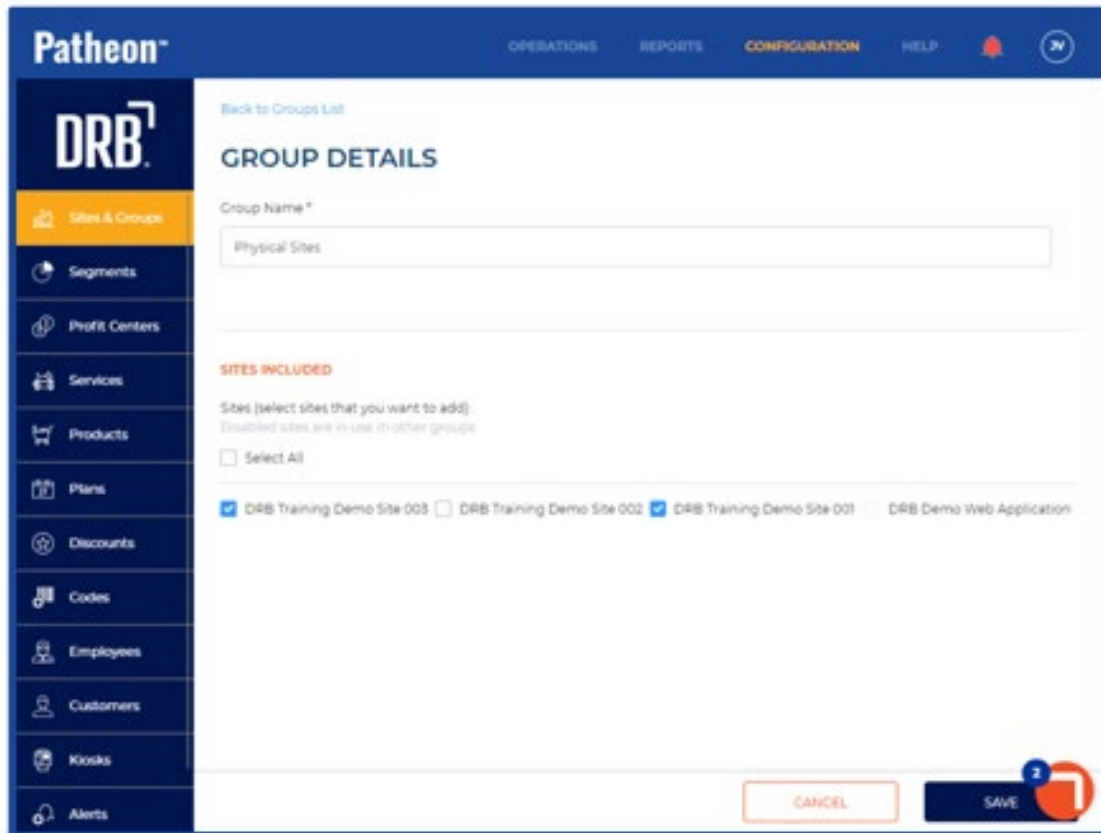
